

St Catherine's Remote Learning Offer


In light of the Government announcement of schools being closed with immediate effect, except for vulnerable children and children of critical workers, your child will be accessing education remotely at home. Below details what our remote package of learning includes, and how it can be accessed.

Children at St Catherine's will receive a daily zoom lesson with their teacher. The zoom link will be emailed to you and it will detail the time of the lesson. The lesson will take place at the same time every day and cover a range of subject areas. During the first week of the new lockdown, your child will have received a pack of resources, and this is all they will need to access the learning tasks.

Additional to the live zoom lesson, your child's teacher will pre-record 2 lessons per day that can be accessed via the remote learning section of the St Catherine's website. These lessons can be accessed at

any point, and new lessons will be uploaded each day. Lessons will cover a range of subject areas including maths, literacy, science, and for KS1, phonics.





Children will also receive a paper-based learning pack that will include daily learning activities to supplement their virtual lessons. These will also cover a range of subject areas including literacy and maths.

A weekly timetable will be sent suggesting how each day could be organised to accommodate the learning. The timetable will also include links to additional learning opportunities e.g. PE, geography, history and music. An example of this timetable is given below.

All children have access to a digital learning platform that will allow them to upload the work they have completed and receive feedback from their teacher.



The children of critical workers and vulnerable children, who continue to attend school, will be able to access the same package of remote learning as those children learning from home.

We appreciate that this is a difficult time, and that supporting your child to learn from home maybe a challenge. We would encourage you to support your child to engage with as much of the remote learning package as you can. We will be registering the children who attend the live zoom sessions and contacting those that don't, in order to offer our support to encourage attendance. The decision to pre-record sessions is to allow flexibility, as we understand that many families will have more than one child that may need to access remote learning and parental support with this. However, we encourage all children to engage with all the opportunities on offer, as it is our intention to offer the teaching of a broad range of curriculum subjects despite these difficult times.
